Mrs. Braynon worked diligently and served 52 years as a Golden Life Member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. This scholarship is awarded to an eligible nursing student who demonstrates:

- Academic excellence and verification of acceptance to a School of Nursing
- Good moral character
- Community service
- Leadership skills and abilities
- Local resident of Broward County
- Evidence of financial need through appropriate documentation

Each succeeding school year, the recipient will provide Delta Sigma Theta Sorority with official verification indicating that:

- He/ She is a full or part time student/undergraduate student
- Major coursework is Nursing
- Cumulative grade point average is at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or 2.0 on a 3.0 scale
- Provide an official transcript at the end of each college year

**Applicants for the Broward County Alumnae Chapter Cora Eaves Braynon Scholarship must be currently enrolled in an accredited School of Nursing pursuing a Bachelors or a Master's degree.**

### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS**

1. Application [Must be written legibly or typed] – application may be obtained from [www.bcacdst.org](http://www.bcacdst.org)
2. Official Transcript (most current)
3. Three Letters of Recommendation. One letter must be from a college professor.
4. Verification of FAMILY income [SAR report and 2018 Federal Income Tax] or FAFSA
5. Essay (750 words) describing why you have chosen a career in nursing, occupational goals, personal goals, and other information such as financial need that may assist in the selection process.
6. Wallet sized photo [yearbook or pass port, NO full body shots]
7. Interview (location TBA) Applicants will be notified.
